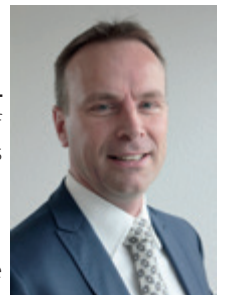
Intergraph Appoints New Leader for Canadian Business Unit
